[1]Wild walking courses are designed to give an awareness of rural environments and encourage people to gain an understanding of the countryside and a greater appreciation for the landscape we live in.



[2]The courses take place just outside London and are within 45 minute train ride from London Euston. This makes the course Ideal for those wanting an easy day or weekend trip, without the long journey times or complex logistics of travelling to the mountains. We spend time learning basic navigation skills and give participants the opportunity to lead the group (under supervision) along various section of the walk. This is a great way to see the contrast of urban and rural life, learn new skills and enjoy the countryside.

As with all our courses, we can tailor the trips to specific needs. The navigation aspects for example can be expanded and would be of great benefit for anyone training towards the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze, Silver or Gold awards.

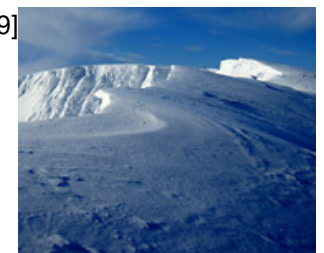
